#### **ENTERING TONIGHT'S GAME**

The SeaWolves couldn't outlast the Flying Squirrels in a back-and-forth battle last night, losing via walk-off for the first time this season on Marco Luciano's sacrifice fly in the ninth inning. Colt Keith's game-tying home run was a highlight for Erie. The lefty swinger is now batting .388 with a 1.131 OPS in 49 at bats against left-handed pitching this season. With their five runs last night, the SeaWolves overtook Double-A Midland as the highest-scoring offense in all of Double-A at 289 runs scored. Kai-Wei Teng will look to stop Erie's potent offense in his third start against the SeaWolves this season. He outdueled today's Erie starter, Sawyer Gipson-Long, in a 2-0 Richmond win at The Diamond on April 22. They also matched up on May 11 at UPMC Park, a game Erie won 6-5. Gipson-Long makes his first start since May 23 after having his last turn skipped to work on adding a cutter to his arsenal.

#### LAST GAME

Despite Colt Keith's heroics, Erie fell in the ninth inning to Richmond, 6-5

The SeaWolves scored first in the second against Richmond starter Mason Black. With two out, Julio Rodriguez doubled. Ben Malgeri followed with an RBI single to start the scoring.

In the bottom of the second, Richmond notched three consecutive two-out singles, including an RBI knock by Brett Auerbach, to tie the game at one

In the fourth, after Andrew Navigato's two-out single, Rodriguez blasted an opposite-field two-run home run to give Erie a 3-1 lead.

The SeaWolves kept that lead until the fifth inning when Madden found immediate trouble on Carter Williams' leadoff double. Vaun Brown scored him with a double and advanced to third on a throwing error by Gage Workman. After Marco Luciano walked, Andy Thomas hit a three-run home run to give Richmond a 5-3 lead.

Wil Jensen, who had replaced Black to begin the fifth inning, allowed a two-out single to Trei Cruz in the seventh. Richmond then brought in left-hander Raymond Burgos to face Colt Keith. Keith blasted a long two-run home run, his tenth of the season, to tie the game at five.

Angel De Jesus stranded two aboard in the eighth inning but could not escape the ninth. Brown had a one-out single and advanced to second on a passed ball and third on a wild pitch. Luciano followed with a sacrifice fly to center to score the winning run.

- -Alvarez is Awesome: This is manager Gabe Alvarez' second season with Erie. Last year, he led Erie to their first 80-win season since 2007.
- -455 Miles too Far: This is the 17th of 24 games between Richmond and Erie in 2023, and the 11th of 12 played at The Diamond.
- -Grounding the Squirrels: Richmond won the season series in 2022, winning 10 of 18 over Erie. But, Erie had the last laugh by sweeping the Squirrels in Southwest Division Series.
- -Heart-Stopping Howlers: Erie has four walk-off wins this season. They have six extra innings wins in eight tries. -Howler Honors: For the week ending on May 21, Colt Keith won Erie's fourth Player of the Week award in 2023. Keith has now won twice, with Trei Cruz and Gage Workman also securing honors.
